



### COLONIAL TRAMCAR RESTAURANT

This winner of the coveted National Tourism Award is a must-do attraction when in Melbourne. These glossy, burgundy restaurants-on-wheels offer a delightful and unique dining experience. As they cruise the streets of Melbourne, diners enjoy fine cuisine and savor the finest Australian wines. The food is prepared on the trams and a Maitre d' oversees the traditional silver and white linen service. Choose from an early dinner (5:45-7:15) or late dinner (8:35-11:30).



### GLOBAL BALLOONING

A sunrise balloon flight over Melbourne is a remarkable experience. In the early morning light, drift over the array of parks and gardens that make Melbourne the world's most liveable city. As the city comes to life, look down on some of the city's iconic sporting venues like the MCG, Melbourne Park and Albert Park racetrack. Complimentary city pickups from major hotels included, returning to hotel at around 9:00am, in time to pick up another tour.



### TRAINS, WINES & WILDLIFE

Ride the historic Puffing Billy Steam Train on Australia's most notable narrow gauge railway. Ride through the lush Sherbrooke Forest filled with giant fern trees and hear the distinctive calls of native animals before sampling traditional Australian billy tea and Lamington cakes. In the Yarra Valley, enjoy a succulent spit roast lunch and sip local wine at Fergusson's Winery. ### GREAT OCEAN ROAD ADVENTURE

The Great Ocean Road is renowned as one of the world's great scenic coastal drives, with its breathtaking scenery and spectacular sheer cliffs. See the Twelve Apostles – limestone stacks rising from the southern ocean, Loch Ard Gorge and London Bridge – incredible landmarks sculpted after millions of years of erosion. The shipwreck coast comes alive with tragic stories of vessels that came to grief on this rugged coast. Return to Melbourne after having a long but spectacular day. (Approx. 9:00am-10:00pm).

### CITY SIGHTS HALF-DAY TOUR
