



FOX GLACIER WALK

FROM FOX GLACIER This half day guided walk is a truly unique experience. Walk beside the river bed to a secret track which winds slowly uphill through temperate rainforest. From high on the track, enjoy fantastic views of the glacier and its icefalls. Continue onto the ice, amongst crevasses and ice ridges and into the middle of the glacier. Return to the bus along a different track. Equipment provided.

FIORDLAND LODGE

PENINSULA ENCOUNTER & ALBATROSS COLONY

FROM DUNEDIN Travel over the scenic peninsula to Taiaroa headland, the famous breeding area of the world's largest seabird, the Royal Albatross. Tour the area and see Albatross soaring around the cliffs. Continue to a private conservation area for close-up viewing of some rare wildlife, including fur seals and yellow-eyed penguins. Return to the city around dusk.
