Vanuatu, formerly known as the New Hebrides, is a Y-shaped archipelago of 83 islands located 500 miles west of Fiji, between New Caledonia and the Solomon Islands.

On arrival in Port Vila you will be transferred to your hotel for a two-night stay. While here, your itinerary includes a tour of Port Vila. Fly to Tanna for two nights. Drive to within 10 minutes of the top of the crater, via Lake Siwi and the ash plain. Watch the lava erupting. (Wear old clothes and sensible footwear. Also, we recommend bandannas as there is a strong sulphurous smell.) The villages are primitive and fascinating. (The roads are unsealed.)

TERMS & CONDITIONS—Please read carefully. Newmans South Pacific Vacations, hereinafter referred to as "Newmans," accepts reservations subject to these Booking Conditions:

1. VALIDITY. This brochure is valid from April 01, 2005 until December 31, 2006 or until superseded.

2. PRICES. Prices in this brochure are quoted in U.S. dollars. Newmans reserves the right to change our prices for any reason. All prices have been calculated based on coach and hotel tariffs and rates of exchange at April 01, 2005. Prices will not be changed after full payment has been received by Newmans for the final invoice price. Prices do not include Taxes, and applicable fees unless specified.

3. DEPOSITS. A minimum non-refundable deposit of US\$200 per person is due and payable when reservations are initiated. A deposit of US\$350 per person is required on all Australian or New Zealand Coach Tours. Additional deposits are required for certain rail journeys, cruises, luxury lodges, exclusive island resort hotels, and non-brochure products. Your Newmans reservations agent or travel agent will advise you of the required additional deposit at the time of making your reservation.

4. FINAL PAYMENT. Final payment must be received by Newmans at least 45 days prior to departure. For reservations made less than 45 days prior to departure, full and final payment is due at the time of making the reservation. Failure to make final payment when due will result in the reservation being automatically canceled and you will be responsible for the cancellation fees specified in Sections 6 and 9. Payment of any money constitutes acceptance of all Terms and Conditions as described herein by the purchaser and/or passenger.

5. METHOD OF PAYMENT. Newmans accepts the following forms of payment: cash, check, money order, Visa, MasterCard, American Express and Discover cards.

6. AIRLINE TICKETING/CANCELLATION. Most airfares used for these vacations are based on Advance Purchase Excursion Fares, and are subject to applicable cancellation penalties and the rules and regulations imposed by each airline. If you cancel your reservation, a cancellation fee will be imposed by the airline of up to 100% of the airfare. Any deviation from the set itinerary may also affect the airfare, and you will be responsible for payment of any increase in the airfare should you change the set itinerary. Newmans must issue all international and domestic air tickets for your vacation; otherwise a service fee of up to US\$150 will be added to the vacation price. After the air ticket is written, any change requiring ticket re-issuance (such as a change in airline dates, routing, stops, or change of name due to the name provided to Newmans not being exactly the same as the name on the passport) will be assessed a US\$100 change fee plus any change and cancellation penalties charged by the airlines. The airfare excludes Taxes and Fees such as: U.S. Departure and Arrival Taxes, Customs and Immigration Fee, Inspection Service Fee, Civil Aviation Security Fee, September 11 Security Fee, Los Angeles P.F.C. Tax, and International landing and departure taxes. You are responsible for paying such additional Taxes and Fees.

7. LATE BOOKING FEE. A US\$50 fee may be levied on bookings requested within 21 days prior to departure to cover communication costs and overnight document delivery fees.

8. AMENDMENTS TO CONFIRMED BOOKINGS. After confirmation has been received there is a US\$100 amendment fee each time an itinerary is revised. No amendments will be made until a deposit is received. Amendments made after documents have been issued will incur a US\$150 fee to cover courier costs, communication costs and additional time to co-ordinate the changes.

9. CANCELLATION FEES. The following cancellation fees will apply on land arrangements based on time before departure that cancellation is advised to Newmans:

45 days or more – Loss of deposit
Between 44-21 days – 20% of total cost
Between 20-10 days – 35% of total cost
Between 9-1 days – 60% of total cost
Day of departure – 100% of total cost

Land arrangements such as but not limited to Blue Lagoon Cruises of Fiji, Captain Cook Cruises of Fiji and Australia, Coral Princess of Australia; Coach Tours; Deluxe Lodges; Treks; Biking and Special Packages: For cancellations within 60 days of use, penalty is assessed by supplier and may be up to 100% of total price.

We strongly recommend travel insurance to cover insurable risks.

10. DOCUMENT DISPATCH. Documents will be dispatched at specified times prior to departure based on when the booking is completed and paid in full.

11. REFUNDS & UNUSED SERVICES. Travel arrangements cancelled, amended or altered within 24 hours of your departure or once travel has commenced do not qualify for any refund whatsoever, whether part of a package vacation or individual components, nor can components be substituted for alternative arrangements. Unused services are not refundable.

12. PASSPORT/VISAS. All passengers require a valid passport and, in most instances, visas. It is the passenger's responsibility to have a valid passport and the necessary visas for the countries being visited. Newmans accepts no responsibility if you do not have the correct documentation for your vacation.

13. WHAT IS NOT INCLUDED. Items of a personal nature such as laundry, drinks, telephone and fax charges, visa and passport fees, vaccinations, meals not specified, gratuities (unless specified), and foreign and domestic departure taxes.

14. ACCOMMODATION. Share twin accommodation is based on two single beds or one double bed as provided by the hotel. Hotels provide triple accommodation generally with a twin or double-bedded room and one rollaway bed at an additional charge. Single room accommodation must be booked by people wishing to travel alone. Special requests such as non-smoking floors or king-size beds cannot be guaranteed.

15. SPECIAL REQUIREMENTS. a) You, the passenger, or your Travel Agent are responsible for advising us of any special requirements you may have and it is your Travel Agent's responsibility to communicate to you any changes or alterations advised to your Travel Agent by Newmans. b) It is your responsibility to advise your Travel Agent in writing of any medical condition that may in any way affect your ability or the ability of any member of your traveling party to undertake the travel arrangements that you have purchased. In addition, you must provide to your Travel Agent a letter from your personal physician stating the nature of the medical condition and certifying that you are physically fit to undertake the travel arrangements as purchased. It is then your Travel Agent's responsibility to provide Newmans with copies of the letter and to request in writing that Newmans arrange any special requirements considered necessary. Without such written notice, Newmans accepts no responsibility for special requirements not provided. Some products in this brochure may require you to undertake medical examinations. You may also be required to show these documents to certain suppliers.

16. RESPONSIBILITY—NEWMANS purchases transportation, hotel accommodations, restaurant services, and other services from various independent suppliers that are not subject to its control. NEWMANS CANNOT, THEREFORE, BE LIABLE FOR ANY PERSONAL INJURY OR PROPERTY DAMAGE, OR ANY OTHER SPECIAL OR CONSEQUENTIAL DAMAGES that may occur due to (a) intentional, wrongful, negligent, or arbitrary acts or omissions on the part of a supplier, its employees and others not under the direct control of NEWMANS, or (b) defects or failures of any aircraft, vessel, automotive vehicle or

other equipment or instrumentality under the control of independent suppliers. In addition, NEWMANS cannot be liable for delays in departure or interruption of your vacation arrangements caused by weather conditions, technical problems of any aircraft, vessel, automotive vehicle or other equipment or instrumentality, strikes, war, terrorist activity, civil commotion, or any causes beyond the control of NEWMANS. In no event will NEWMANS be responsible for incidental, consequential or special or incidental damage or loss suffered by any person. NEWMANS' maximum liability, for any reason whatsoever, will be limited to the amount paid to NEWMANS for its services. In issuing tickets and coupons for transportation of the purchaser by any means, and making arrangements for hotel or other accommodation, NEWMANS is not acting as principal but only as agent for the companies, corporations or persons providing or offering the means of transportation and accommodation. To the extent NEWMANS shall not be acting as an agent, as stated above, it shall be deemed to be acting as an agent of the purchasers in arranging or booking transportation and accommodation. Airlines and other transportation providers (e.g., motor coach operators) are not liable for any detention, delays, loss, damage, sickness or injury, however or by whomsoever caused, during the time passengers are not on board their planes or conveyances. The contract of carriage used by such transportation providers when issued shall constitute the sole contract between the transportation providers and the purchaser of these vacation arrangements.

17. TRAVEL INSURANCE. Newmans strongly recommends you purchase travel insurance providing coverage for loss of deposit, cancellation fees, medical expenses, lost baggage and other potential travel-related losses under certain circumstances. Such insurance must be purchased at the time of your initial travel reservation, and paid for with your deposit. The scope of coverage is subject to the terms and conditions of the insurance policy. Our "No Worries Waiver" covers cancellation fees NOT protected by Travel Insurance, for cancellations up to 72 hours prior to departure. Certain exclusions apply. Ask for details.

18. MAPS AND PHOTOGRAPHS. Maps shown within this brochure are for general information only and may not necessarily reflect actual routings and services provided. The hotel photographs may not necessarily reflect the standard of any room purchased.

19. IMPORTANT NOTE. We are required under California law to advise you of the following: For passengers located in California only, in the event of Newmans' default, you may be eligible for a refund of up to US\$15,000 from the California Travel Consumer Restitution Fund. If you were located in California at the time of your purchase, you have a right to make a claim against the fund for a refund of any money paid to Newmans that is due because of Newmans bankruptcy, insolvency, cessation of operations, or material failure to provide the transportation or travel services sold.
